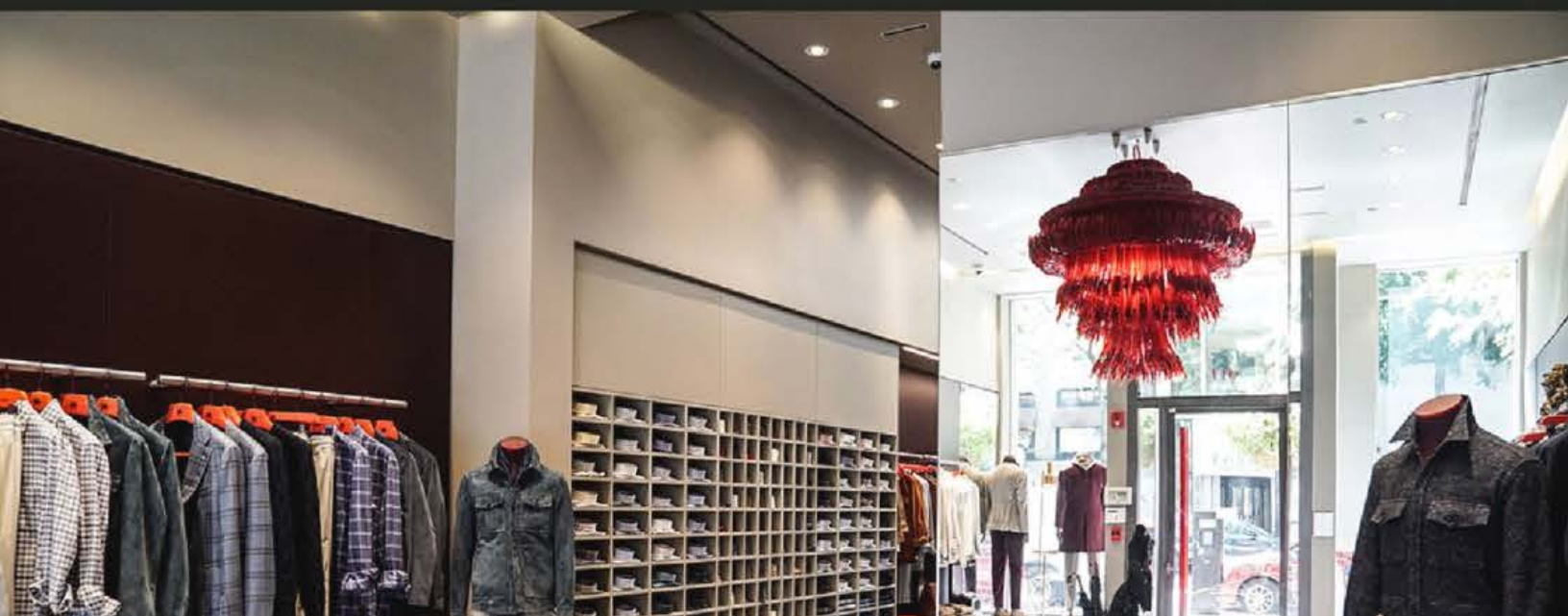




# LUXURY & LEGACY

Oak Street has been cultivating its identity for decades.



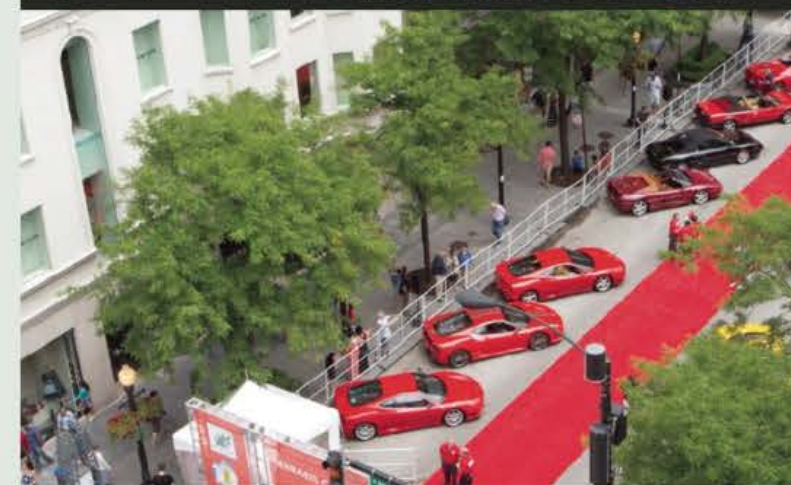
With impeccable displays by luxury boutiques that turn window shopping into a spectator sport, Oak Street delivers an experience unlike anywhere else in Chicago.

“An enclave for Chicagoans following the Chicago Fire of 1871,” Oak Street holds good company with other world-class shopping districts such as Rodeo Drive in Beverly Hills, Upper 5th Avenue in New York City, and Bond Street in London.

Oak Street is the Midwest’s premier, luxury shopping district where people can enjoy exploring international fashion houses and regional brands in the heart of Chicago’s Gold Coast.

Oak Street’s world-class shopping experience began in 1969 when Joan Weinstein opened Ultimo and became a driving force for making Oak Street what it is today. Weinstein’s boutique introduced Chicagoans to designers such as Azzedine Alaïa, Dolce & Gabbana, Sonia Rykiel, Jil Sander, and Giorgio Armani.

Much of Oak Street’s luxury reputation was cultivated by Chicago-born businesswoman Marilyn Miglin. In 1963, Miglin, a former model, opened Marilyn Miglin Model Makeup at 112 E. Oak. Miglin established a cosmetics empire, becoming one of the most recognizable personalities on the Home
